The Alberta <u>CheckFirst</u> or British Columbia <u>InvestRight</u> websites are investor resources designed to educate and protect investors and to help them avoid fraudulent companies and risky investments. Investors should use them to:

- 1. **Verify Registrations** Check if an investment firm or advisor is properly registered to operate in Alberta or British Columbia.
- 2. **Identify Scams** Learn about common investment scams and how to spot red flags.
- 3. **Understand Risks** Access educational resources on different investment types and their risks.
- 4. **Report Concerns** Find guidance on reporting potential fraud or misconduct.

Before investing, investors should use <u>CheckFirst</u> or <u>InvestRight</u> to confirm legitimacy, protect their assets, and stay informed about safe investment practices.
